Important Information to Note:

- The event is for Collector Cars and Specialty Vehicles.
- The Manitoba Airshow and Pistons & Props Car Show are cashless events; plan to use a credit or debit card for any purchases.
- Unfortunately, we won't be able to take photos of our vehicles with the planes.
- MSRA has secured a large tent for participants to seek shelter from the weather.
- **No other tents, canopies, large umbrellas, or flags of any sort can be on-site.** In the event of a fly-over or inclement weather, these can become projectiles and could cause injury to participants/spectators and/or damage to vehicles and planes.
- You must pre-register AND attend the show to receive your t-shirt at the subsidized cost.
- The nearby golf course will be closed on Saturday and Sunday during the air show.

Do I need to attend both days of the car show?

- You can attend both days but you don't have to. When pre-registering, you will be asked to select the day(s) you are attending: Saturday only; Sunday only; or both Saturday and Sunday.

What is the entry & exit procedure?

- All show vehicles will meet at a specified mustering point in Portage la Prairie in the morning on both Saturday and Sunday. We will then parade into the site reserved for us at the Air Show. Information on the location of the muster point and departure time will be made available once these plans have been confirmed.
- The road in and out of the Air Show is paved.
- You will be directed to a parking spot once you arrive at the Southport Air Show grounds.
- All vehicles must stay in their designated parking spots for the entire day. **Plan on being there until 5:00 p.m.**
- Drivers can pick up their registration items and pre-ordered t-shirts at the MSRA Table after parking their vehicle.
- Car show vehicles will leave after the spectators have cleared the grounds. We are anticipating this to be around 5:00 p.m. MSRA has planned a fun activity, with some great prizes which will take place from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m.

I'm towing my vehicle to the car show. Where can I park my truck and trailer?

- Trailers can be parked at the Portage la Prairie Mall on the west side of town or at the Rotary Republic Park across Highway #1, just off Highway #240.

What about food?

- Participants are welcome to bring their own food.
- Snacks and water will be available for car show participants in the tented area.
- Vendors will be available for participants and spectators to purchase food on site.
- **Note: All purchases will require a credit/debit card as the site is cash-less.**

What can we expect once we're on-site?

- Car clubs can raise their profile with a very large audience and, perhaps, sign up new members. Clubs are encouraged to park as a group, noting the airshow's restrictions around tents, canopies, large umbrellas, or flags outlined above.
- You will showcase your collectible vehicle while sharing your love of the automotive hobby.
- We will mingle and mix with other fellow car enthusiasts while checking out the other vehicles from a variety of car clubs.
- We will enjoy all the features of the Air Show, at no cost to ourselves. This will include:
 - Checking out the static plane display and learning more about the RCAF that is celebrating 100 years.
 - Enjoying an awesome afternoon of exciting adventures in the sky.
 - Purchasing additional Piston & Props t-shirts if you wish; including children's sizes.
 - Having fun when you participate in our daily *Trivia/Scavenger Hunt Contest* with an opportunity to win some fantastic prizes!
